"the manner in which power is exercised in the management of a country's economic and social resources for development"


# **CORRUPTION** (World Bank)

Corruption is "the abuse of public office for private gain..."


It covers a wide range of behavior, from bribery to theft of public funds. Corruption exists all over the world, but it is usually present in countries with weak institutions, often affected by fragility and conflict

Corruption perpetuates poverty, sows insecurity and robs the world's most vulnerable people of desperately needed funds and public services.



### Corruption costs lives.

**~\$500** billion of funding destined for health services is lost to corruption every year.

This corruption in the health sector kills an estimated 140,000 children a year, fuels the global rise in antimicrobial resistance, and hampers the fight against HIV/AIDS and countries' ability to respond to pandemics.

Corruption has been a driving force behind some of the deadliest conflicts in recent history. It helps create the conditions in which these conflicts can thrive.

Corruption perpetuates poverty, inequality and injustice, wastes funds that could be spent on development and security, and facilitates the operations of extremist groups and organized crime syndicates.

Data that can be freely used freely reused and redistributed by anyone for any purpose

### What makes data truly open?




### **Technically Open**

- Easy online access to all unrestricted datasets
- Data catalog with metadata
- Available for download in multiple formats (CSV, Excel, JSON, etc.) (ODC-BY)
- Provide Open API access to the data

### Legally Open

- No restrictions on use and/or redistribution
- The data must be available under an open license
- Open Data Commons Attribution License








# **Integrated Indicator Profile**




