subject Correspondence with the Government of Brazil

The Permanent Mission of Brazil has brought to the attention of my office that on several occasions recently communications have been directed to the Brazilian Government through the Office of the General Secretariat in Brasilia, rather than through the Permanent Mission.

I wish to recall once again that the Permanent Mission provides the sole official channel for communication with the Government of Brazil.

I shall appreciate your taking measures to ensure that all communications addressed to the Brazilian Government--particularly those prepared in the secretariats of the Inter-American Economic and Social Council and the Inter-American Council for Education, Science and Culture--take the form of correspondence directed to the Permanent Mission.
