



What is it?

A virtual space for young people aged 15 to 17 from English-speaking countries in the Americas, designed to reflect, propose, and share ideas on how to strengthen democratic life in your school and community.

Why participate?

Because what you think matters and can inspire ideas in other people. Although everyone will work at their own pace, you will be able to see what others are posting, get inspired, and add your comments.

This way, together, we will create a space full of different points of view.

How does it work?

The forum takes place in several phases that you can complete at your own pace over two weeks:

▶ Identify your context

Reflect on your surroundings and what makes them valuable

Identify a challenge

Analyze a real situation that affects your community

Be informed

Access videos and materials that will help you understand the importance of being well informed so you can take action.

Be proactive and get involved

Design a viable proposal to address the challenge

Comment and collaborate

Review others' ideas and contribute suggestions.

- Videos: "Participate," "Be informed," and "Common good."
- Infographics and other materials with relevant data and information.

Where?

You will access all the resources from a website: videos, infographics, and direct links to the Forums. You will be able to post your contributions, as well as view and comment on those of others.

What do you need?

Internet access and a device (computer, tablet, or cell phone)
